On March 10, 2020 at 1:26am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle in the 26000 block of Lake Road for a moving traffic violation. When police attempted to catch up to the vehicle, it pulled into a residential driveway and turned off the cars light. Police spoke with the female operator who was evasive with her answers. Police investigated and found that the male rear passenger, a 30 year-old Elyria resident, was originally operating the vehicle and switched into the backseat when the vehicle was stopped. The male, who appeared to be under the influence of alcohol, continually lied to police about his real identity.

The male refused to take field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. He also refused to submit to a breath test to measure his blood alcohol content. The male was charged with numerous charges including felony OVI. In addition, the male had an active warrant with the Rocky River Police Department. He is facing numerous charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On March 11, 2020 at 12:29am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Bassett Road at the railroad tracks for a moving traffic violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 21 year-old Avon resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .033 blood alcohol content. The male also admitted to smoking marijuana earlier in the evening and submitted to a urine test. The male was charged accordingly and will face charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On March 13, 2020 at 1:38pm, Bay Village Police were called to the area of East Oakland Road and Forestview Road on report of a reckless operator. Police arrived on scene and spoke with the complainant who stated that an unusually loud Ford sedan was racing down the street with two males inside. Police arrived and located the suspect vehicle at a nearby home. Police spoke with the vehicle's owner who admitted that he was working on the vehicle and was test driving it. The male was strongly warned about his speeding and having a working muffler on the vehicle.
