On July 20, at 4:52am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the 400 block of Pellett Drive on report of a stolen vehicle. The owner reported that she was awakened by the sound of a vehicle starting outside of her home. The victim looked outside and noticed her Lexus was missing from the driveway. The victim admitted that the vehicle was left unlocked with her keys and her purse inside of the vehicle. While investigating this complaint, Bay Village Police spoke with a nearby neighbor who also reported their driveway. The neighbor stated that he had left the keys in the unlocked Toyota that was subsequently stolen. Bay Village Detectives are investigating both thefts.

On the morning of July 20, the Bay Village Police took seven different Theft from Auto reports on the west side of the city, particularly in the area of Powell Drive, Pellett Drive and Clarewood Drive. In all of these incidents, items were taken from unlocked vehicles. The Bay Village Police department would like to remind residents to remove valuables from their vehicles and lock their doors in the overnight hours.

On July 24 at 10:44am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the 25000 block of Lake Road on report of a stolen auto. Police arrived and spoke with the victim who stated their Acura was stolen from the driveway in the overnight hours. The owner admitted that the keys were in the vehicle and it was left unlocked. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.

On July 25, at 8:55pm, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle in the area of Columbia Road south of Lake Road for a moving traffic violation. Police spoke with the operator, a 58 year old Bay Village resident who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male refused to provide a breath sample to determine his blood alcohol content. He is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
