Luckily, the check has not been cashed and she is not out any money. It was determined that the U.S.P.S. was aware of the problem and that Postal Inspectors were investigating.

Police arrived and found that the altercation started because the father took the child's phone as punishment for violating several house rules. The teen became angry and started a scuffle. Luckily, there were no injuries. The teenage son was arrested for domestic violence and was eventually transported to the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Justice Center to face charges.
