



## **Bay Village Press Release**

**5/25/2020**

On May 20, at 12:35am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the 27000 block of Lake Road on report of suspicious vehicle. Police arrived and found the male operator, a 44 year old Bay Village resident, was behind the wheel and unresponsive. Police suspected a possible overdose and Bay Village Paramedics were called to take the male to the hospital. The male is facing charges for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence upon receipt of lab results. He is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On May 22, at 10:13am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to Cahoon Park west of the Bay Village Boat Club on report of criminal damaging. Police arrived and found that a construction vehicle had been severely damaged. The property owner showed police where windows were smashed with a rock, control levers jammed, fuses taken out and sand put into fuel tanks. The property owner expects repairs to cost over \$3000. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.

On May 22, at 12:42am, a Kenilworth Road resident arrived at Bay Village Police to report a theft from her home. The homeowner told police that someone stole a laptop from her home. She saw the laptop just a few days prior in a familiar location in her home. When she went to use it next a couple of days later, it was gone. The homeowner stated that the only other people in the home during that time frame worked for a cleaning service. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.
