On October 15, at 12:06am, Bay Village Police were in the area of Lake Road, east of Cahoon Road, checking Cahoon Park when they noticed a male duck down and then run from them. Police eventually caught two males, one adult and one juvenile, who were found nearby. After an investigation, both males were charged with possession of marijuana and the juvenile was also charged with a curfew violation.

On October 15, 2019 at 8:47am, a resident in the 600 block of Columbia Road called Bay Police to report that a dog has been barking on the street behind her home for the last 30 mins. Police arrived but could not find the source of the commotion. As this happens regularly, residents are encouraged to call about on-going noise complaints while they are happening. This allows officers to easily locate the problem and act accordingly.

On October 16, at 2:06am Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Lake Road at the County line for several moving violations. Police suspected that the female operator, a 27 year-old Avon Lake resident, was under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the female submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .113 blood alcohol content. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
