On October 24, at 1:59am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Lake Road and Porter Creek when they noticed a male riding a bike on the sidewalk. When the male saw the police, he dismounted, jumped a guardrail and fled from police. The suspect was eventually found hiding in the woods. The male, a 20 year old Bay Village resident was found to be under the influence of alcohol. He was placed under arrest and is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On October 26, at 1:31 am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Columbia Road near Eaton Way when it was found that the registered owner was under a driving suspension. When speaking with the female operator, a 39 year old Sheffield Lake resident, officers found that she was under the influence of alcohol. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. Officers also found an open container of alcohol inside of the vehicle. On station, the operator refused to submit to a breath test. She is facing multiple charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On October 26, at 8:35am, it was reported to Bay Village Police that two bikes were stolen from outside of the Bay High Football game that occurred Friday night October 25. Police are investigating.

Residents are encouraged to lock their bikes when they are left in public. Additionally, residents are encouraged to get a free bike license from the Bay Village Police Department. This helps greatly when bikes are stolen and/or recovered as police maintain the important information on file regarding serial numbers and owner information.
