On August 27, at 1:29am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Clague Road for a moving traffic violation. Police stopped the vehicle and spoke with the male operator, a 34 year-old Cleveland resident who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to a urine test. He is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court. Additional charges are pending the results of tests.

On August 28, at 2:50am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Lake Road, east of Columbia Road for a moving traffic violation. Police stopped the vehicle and spoke with the female operator, a 25 year-old Lakewood resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .19 blood alcohol content. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On August 29, the Bay Village Police Department took several Theft from Auto reports. The six reports were taken in the area south of Wolf Road and east of Columbia Road. All of the vehicles were left unlocked. Numerous items were taken including a laptop and a credit card which was later used at a gas station. Bay Village Detectives are investigating. Police request residents lock their vehicles and remove valuables from plain sight.
