



## **Bay Village Press Release**

**9/21/2020**

On September 13, 2020 at 9:37 pm, Bay Village Police received a report of a possible intoxicated driver heading westbound on Lake Road committing numerous traffic violations. Bay Police found the suspect vehicle on Kenmore Drive, north of Lake Road. Officers stopped the vehicle and found an 18 year-old, Rocky River male, operating the vehicle. Officers spoke with the operator who appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .198 blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On September 14 2020, at 3:45pm Bay Village Police were dispatched to the Bay Village High School to take a Criminal Damaging report. Officers arrived and spoke with a high school staff member who reported that his vehicle was “keyed” during the school day. The matter is under investigation while the school is reviewing security camera footage.

On September 18, 2020 at 12:57am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Bay Methodist Church when they noticed a suspicious vehicle stopped in the church lot. Officers investigated and found a 22 year-old Bay Village male behind the wheel. Officers spoke with the operator who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .133 blood alcohol content. During a search of the vehicle, officers found an open container of alcohol, marijuana, and marijuana paraphernalia. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
