On Thursday November 18, at 12:50am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of West Oviatt and Sutcliff Drive when they stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 53 Bay Village resident who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male refused to submit to an Intoxilyzer test to check his blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On Wednesday November 18, Bay Village Police responded to the Bay Village Heinens on report a Protection Order Violation. Police investigated and found the male suspect, a 50 year Medina resident, was with his wife, she being listed as the protected person in the protection order. The male was taken into custody and is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On November 20, at 6:56, Bay Village Police Officers were dispatched to Kimerly Drive on report of a burglary. Officers arrived and found that the back door had been broken into. The homeowners could not give a definitive time frame of the break in as they had been away for several days. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.

On Saturday November 21, at 4:05pm Bay Village Police were dispatched to the station lobby to take a Fraud Report. The victim, a Bates Drive resident, reported that someone had attempted to file unemployment benefits in her name. The victim was able to coordinate with her employer and make sure the claim did not go through. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.
