On December 3, at 10:07am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to assist a Walker Road resident who was the victim of a fraud. The victim reported that she received a letter from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services in regard to an unemployment application that was filed in her name. The victim contacted the agency which advised her to their Fraud Department. The victim also called the credit bureaus to monitor her accounts.

On December 4, at 5:39pm, Bay Village Police received a call from a West Oakland resident who reported she had been contacted 35 times over the last two days from "Apple Support Systems." The victim stated that the numbers appeared to be local, coming from a 440 area code and that she knew it was a scam. The victim was referred to her service provider to have the calls blocked.

On December 8, at 1:36am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Wolf Road near Huntmere Road for a moving traffic violation. Police spoke with the occupants of the vehicle, a 28 year-old female from Vincent, Ohio, and two males, 23 and 28 years of age respectively, both from Marietta, Ohio. The trio appeared suspicious in their actions and a canine unit was requested from Rocky River Police. Once the canine unit arrived, the trio admitted to having marijuana, drug paraphernalia and drug abuse instruments on their person and inside the vehicle. After further investigation, suspected heroin and meth were also found in the vehicle. This was later sent out for testing. The group was brought back to the Bay Village Police Department to await an appearance on their charges at Rocky River Municipal Court.
