On December 17, 2020 at 3:25pm, Bay Village Police received a call from a Juneway Drive resident who stated that someone had entered her unlocked vehicle and stole credit cards from inside the vehicle. She noticed this when she received a call from Chase Bank reporting fraudulent charges on her card. Upon investigation, it was found that charges totaling \$675 had been made on the stolen cards. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.

On December 18, 2020 at 1:32pm, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the police station lobby to take a fraud report. Officers were met there by the victim, a Glen Park Drive resident, who reported that someone had attempted to file for unemployment benefits in her name. The victim was able to contact the unemployment office to straighten the matter out and is not out any money. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On December 20, 2020 at 12:33am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Bassett Road, at the railroad tracks for an equipment violation. Police spoke with the female operator, an 18 year old Bay Village resident, and the female passenger, a 19 year old Westlake resident. While speaking with the pair, the officer noticed that there was contraband inside of the vehicle. Additionally, when the officer spoke with operator, she appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the underage operator provided a breath sample with showed a .042 blood alcohol content. The operator is charged with an (underaged) OVI. Additionally, the operator admitted ownership of the contraband and will be

charged with possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia in Rocky River
Municipal Court.
