AGE: 21-35 YEARS OF AGE AT TIME OF APPOINTMENT

EDUCATION: HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR GED

All interested applicants **must** also complete a City of Bay Village Civil Service application by February 22, 2021. Applications can be obtained at Bay Village City Hall, Bay Village Police Department, or by going to <https://www.cityofbayvillage.com/157/Human-Resources> (applications can be found under "Open Positions").

Completed Civil Service applications must be NOTARIZED and submitted in person or via the United States Postal Service to:

Completed applications must be submitted in-person or postmarked no later than February 22, 2021 by 4:00pm. Applications **will not** be accepted after February 22, 2021.

To be eligible to receive extra credit points, you **must** provide the following documentation when submitting your application:

1. Two-year Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement, or Police Science Associate Degree, OR, four-year BA, BS, or AB Degree from an accredited college in any field. The City of Bay Village only recognizes degrees granted from a university or college if the degree granting institution is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting organization. The accrediting organization must be recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or the Council for Higher Education Accreditation. Proof of education must be submitted with application. (5 points)
2. Current Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) Certification for full-time officer, plus two-years of experience or (4160 hours equivalent) as a sworn Police Officer (i.e. municipal or township police officer, deputy sheriff, university police officer, Ohio State Patrol Officer, or CMHA Police Officer). A copy of your OPOTA certification must be submitted with application. (5 points)
3. Current Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) Certification for full-time officer, with less than two-years of experience as a sworn Police Officer. A copy of your OPOTA certification must be submitted with application. (2 points)
4. Military veterans who have served at least one year active duty and have been HONORABLY DISCHARGED. A copy of your DD214 must be submitted with application. (5 points)

Prior to appointment applicants must possess a current Police Physical Agility Test Certificate from Cuyahoga Community College.
