On January 29, at 11:37am the Bay Village Police Department took a Fraud report from an Osborn Road resident. The victim reported that she received a 1099 tax form for unemployment benefits that were filed in her name. The victim, who is self-employed, did not file for these benefits. The victim was referred to the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services and the credit bureaus to monitor her accounts. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On January 30, 2021 at 11:39am, Bay Village Police Department took a Theft from Auto report. Officers spoke with the female victim, an East Oviatt Road, resident who reported that sometime in the overnight hours of Wednesday January 27, someone entered her unlocked auto and stole cash, identification, and credit cards. The victim was advised to cancel her credit cards and notify her bank. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On January 31, at 12:36am, Bay Village Police checked on a suspicious car that had pulled into the Bay Village City Hall parking lot. When police investigated, they found that the vehicle had a flat tire. Police spoke with the male operator, a 41 year old, North Ridgeville resident, who appeared to be under the influence. He also admitted to striking a curb resulting in the flat tire. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male refused to submit to an Intoxilyzer test to determine his blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
