On 02/13/2021, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Bradley for a traffic violation. The 42-yoa female driver of the vehicle was found to also have a suspended driver's license and neither of the male passengers had a valid license. While conducting an inventory of the vehicle prior to towing it, numerous drugs and drug paraphernalia were located. The driver of the vehicle was subsequently arrested on various drug charges and Driving Under Suspension. The Ashtabula resident will face charges at RRMC. Charges area also pending lab results for one of the passengers, a 53-yoa male from Ashtabula.

On 02/12/2021, at 2101 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. at Saddler for a traffic violation. After speaking with the 64-yoa male driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI.
