



Bay Village Press Release

On February 17, at 3:46pm, an Elmwood Road resident arrived on station to report his home was burglarized at some point over the last few days. Specifically, the male reported that money was taken from the home. The male could not name any suspects but stated a young white male was in the area during the time frame who he assumed was working for the gas company. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.

Bay Village Police remind residents to call right away if they see anything suspicious.

On February 18, at 10:30am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Columbia Road, just south of the city line for an equipment violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 20 year old Berea resident, and quickly noticed the odor of marijuana. Officers spoke with the male and a probable cause search was conducted. Numerous items of drugs and drug paraphernalia were found inside the vehicle, including a realistic looking pellet gun. This was found loaded in the glove box. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court and may face additional charges pending drug lab analysis.

On February 19, at 11:57pm, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Wolf Road and Bracken Way when they stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 48 year old, Rocky River resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed

a .145 blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On February 21, at 2:17am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Columbia Road and Wolf Road when they noticed a vehicle that had made a moving violation. Police eventually stopped the vehicle at Columbia Road and Detroit Road in Westlake. Police spoke with the male operator, a 45 year old Westlake resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male refused a breathalyzer test to determine his blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
