**A RESOLUTION**

**AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING THE  
MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY  
MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS  
THROUGH THE 2020 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program is to award one-year grants directly to fire departments to enhance their abilities with respect to fire and fire-related equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bay Village Fire Department has partnered with the Fairview Park Fire Department to prepare a joint grant application to replace unusable radio equipment to meet current standards; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for the purchase of this equipment is available through the FEMA 2020 AFG Program with a local cost-share of \$27,883.46, equal to 10% of the federal share of \$278,834.64 on a total project cost of \$306,718.10;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Council hereby authorizes the filing of the application and, if awarded, entering into an agreement with the Federal Emergency Management Agency to administer the 2020 Assistance to Firefighters Grant, and that the Mayor is authorized to sign said agreement.

**SECTION 2.** That the Mayor hereby requests the Federal Emergency Management Agency consider and fund the application project.

**SECTION 3.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


**SECTION 4.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to file said application in a timely manner, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
