On March 17, 2021 at 10:28pm, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Wolf Road and Forestview Road when they saw a vehicle operating at a high rate of speed. Police eventually stopped the vehicle and spoke with the male operator, a 34 year old, Bay Village resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .137 blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On March 18, 2021 at 12:00pm, a Manhasset Road resident arrived on station to report she was the victim of a fraud. The victim told officers that she was attempting to buy a house. When she went to check her credit, it showed that she had a debt of over \$3000. When she looked into the matter, she found that someone had purchased electronics in her name. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On March 21, 2021 at 3:06am, Bay Village Police were in the area of Lake Road and Rye Gate Road when they stopped a vehicle for numerous moving violations. Police spoke with the male operator, a 24 year old Willoughby Hills resident, who had a suspended driver's license and appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .117 blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
