On March 24, 2021 at 4:55pm, Bay Village Police received a call from a Knickerbocker Road resident who reported a fraud. The victim reported to police that he received a notification from Amazon indicating his password had been changed. He contacted Amazon regarding the issue but was locked out of his account. The victim then began receiving fraud alerts from his credit card accounts, indicating his cards have been used numerous times. He was referred to the credit card companies and the Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On March 27, 2021 at 2:18am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Wolf Road and Oakmoor Road when they stopped a vehicle for numerous moving violations. Police spoke with the female operator, a City of Lorain resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The female operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the female refused to submit to an Intoxilyzer test to show her blood alcohol content. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On March 27, 2021 at 5:56pm, Bay Village Police conducted a traffic stop in the area of Cahoon Road and Wolf Road. While speaking with the operator, the officer noticed the smell of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The three male occupants of the vehicle, all 18 year old Bay Village residents, admitted to having marijuana and alcohol inside the vehicle. In addition, two of the males had fake identification in their possession. The operator was cited for possession of marijuana and driving under suspension. One of the passengers was charged with

underage possession of alcohol. The fake id's were confiscated. Both are facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On March 27, 2021 at 10:11pm, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Beach Land and West Oakland Road when they stopped a vehicle for a moving traffic violation. Police spoke with the female operator, a 40 year old North Royalton resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator refused to submit to an Intoxilyzer test to show her blood alcohol content. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
