On Tuesday March 30, at 12:28am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Wolf Road and Clague Road when they stopped a vehicle for a license violation. When police spoke with the female operator, they noticed the distinct odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. After a search of the vehicle, the operator was cited with possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia and for not having an operator's license. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On Friday April 2, at 9:04pm, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Dover Center Road and Normandy Road when they stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Police spoke with the female operator, a 56 year old Cleveland resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator submitted to a urine test to check for prohibited substances in her system. The operator is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court with additional charges pending lab results.

On Saturday April 3, at 10:15pm, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Clague Road and Russell Road when they stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. Police spoke with the female operator, a 32 year old Cleveland resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .363 blood alcohol content. The operator is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
