On April 13, at 4:30pm, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the 26000 block of Wolf Road on report of a theft. Police arrived and spoke with the homeowner who reported someone had stolen the catalytic converter from his vehicle between March 29 and April 10. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On April 13 at 11:44pm, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Lake Road, east of Clague Road when they stopped a vehicle for an expired license plate. The plate was last registered in December of 2016. It was also discovered that the owner was showing a suspended license. The vehicle was towed until the owner could provide proper registration.

On April 17, at 10:39am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the 31000 block of Marvis Drive on report of neighbor dispute. Police arrived and found that there was a verbal confrontation over the location of the property line and an impending fence installation. Both were advised to the building department for clarification on the property lines and to have no other contact with each other.

On April 17 at 1:48pm, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the 28000 block of Lincoln Road on report of a Fraud. Police arrived and spoke with resident. The resident reported that she had given her credit card number to a group claiming to be supporting law enforcement. She was advised to her credit card companies to put a fraud alert on her credit cards.

Residents are advised to never give their credit card number or personal information out over the phone. There are organizations that claim to support law

enforcement but the Bay Village Police Department would never solicit for funds in this manner.

On April 17, at 10:08pm, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Clague Road and Bruce Road when they stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 30 year old Cleveland resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male refused to submit to an Intoxilyzer test to show his blood alcohol content. He is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
