On April 21 at 12:57am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Clague Road and Bruce Road when they stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. The male operator, a 32 year old Cleveland resident, appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male refused to take an Intoxilyzer test to show his blood alcohol content. A male passenger, a 52 year old Cleveland resident, was cited for marijuana possession. Both males are facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On April 23 at 3:46am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Columbia Road and Wolf Road when they stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. The female operator, a 22 year old Jamestown New York resident, appeared to be under the influence. A male passenger also appeared to be under the influence. The female failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. During the stop, marijuana was also found in the vehicle. On station, the female provided a breath sample for the Intoxilyzer test which showed a .180% blood alcohol content. The male passenger was later picked up by a family member and the operator was released on bond to the same. The operator is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On April 25 at 2:16am, Bay Village Police were on patrol when they noticed a vehicle parked in the back lot of Bay Presbyterian Church. Officers spoke with the three juveniles in the vehicle and advised them of curfew laws. Parents were

notified and arrived on scene to take possession of their children. None were charged but they were strongly advised.

On April 25 at 3:20am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Lake Road and Lake Forest Road when they stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 32 year old Westlake resident, who appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male provided a breath sample for an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .197% blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
