



## **Bay Village Press Release**

**5/10/2021**

On May 3, 2021 at 12:47am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Bradley Road Park when they found a vehicle parked on the basketball court. Police spoke with four adult males using the lights from their vehicle to play basketball. They also noticed there was a strong odor of marijuana coming from inside their vehicle. After a search, marijuana was discovered inside the car. The males were cited for park hours and the marijuana was confiscated. They are facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On May 4, 2021 at 4:46pm, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the station lobby to take a fraud report. Officers met the victim who stated that he had received a default notification from a collections agency. They told him that an ATT account had been opened in his name in 2020 with an address in Murfreesborough, Tennessee. The total amount owed was just over \$1000 dollars. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On May 4, 2021 at 9:56pm, Bay Village Police received a 911 call reporting an accident in the area of Lake Road and Clague Road. Police arrived on scene and spoke with the female operator, a 26 year old Cleveland resident, who was involved in the single car crash. A squad was called for the operator and she was cleared by medics. While speaking with the female, officers noticed that she was possibly intoxicated. The female failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the female refused to provide a breath sample to determine her blood alcohol content. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On May 9, 2021 at 3:08am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the 31000 block of Lake Road on report of a single car crash. Police arrived and found that the vehicle involved had struck a pole, shearing it off at the base. Police spoke with the male vehicle operator, a 20 year old North Olmsted resident, who appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The uninjured male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. During a search of the vehicle, drug paraphernalia and a fake ID were discovered. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .058 blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
