



## **Bay Village Press Release**

**06/08/2021**

On 05/31/2021, at 2256 hrs, BVPD units were dispatched to the 400 block of Elmwood for a noise complaint. Upon arrival to the area, officers located a group of 5-6 young adults playing basketball and listening to music. They were all advised of the complaint and shut it down for the night.

On the morning of 06/01/2021, numerous residents in the area of 27000 Knickerbocker and East Oviatt had their vehicles entered overnight. BVPD reminds residents to lock your vehicles and remove all valuables.

On 06/03/2021, at 2331 hrs, North Olmsted Police were investigating a possible assault/stolen car that originated at the Back Draft in their city. The suspect from the incident was possibly headed to a house in Bay Village on Columbia Rd. Officers were dispatched to check the house. Officers confirmed the male suspect was in the house. After a short foot pursuit in the backyard the 37-yoa male was taken into custody. The Olmsted Falls resident was turned over to North Olmsted Police.

On 06/05/2021, at 2147 hrs, a Buchanan resident reported that three of his children's unlocked bicycles were stolen from Dairy Queen. BVPD took a report on the incident and were investigating when the owner located the three bicycles at Huntington Beach. All the bicycles were undamaged and unattended when recovered. BVPD reminds residents to please lock your bicycles when unattended.

On 06/01/2021, at 2037 hrs, BVPD officers were dispatched to the 500 block of Oakmoor to investigate suspicious circumstances at a house. A resident called to report his neighbor lived out of town and the house should be vacant, but there were people living at the house. Officers spoke with the occupant of the house who stated she had permission from the owner to be at the house, and was cleaning up the house while she stayed there. Officers confirmed her story

with the out of state owner. Officers also discovered that the female staying at the house had an active warrant with North Olmsted Police. She was taken into custody on the strength of the warrant and transported to North Olmsted Police Department.
