

## Bay Village Press Release 06/15/2021

On 06/12/2021, at 0103 hrs, a resident in the 500 block of Cahoon reported her house was egged and pizza was thrown all over their cars. BVPD officers responded to the area but were unable to locate the subjects responsible. Police are investigating.

On 06/11/2021, at 1338 hrs, BVPD officers were dispatched to CVS for an irate customer. Officers spoke with staff members who reported the female customer was irate over the wait time in the drive thru Pharmacy due to the customers in front of her getting Covid tests. The customer was advised of the complaint and left the property per the request of CVS management.

On 06/11/2021, at 1521 hrs, a resident in the 24000 block of Wolf Rd. reported she was the victim of identity fraud. Someone opened up a credit card using her personal information, and purchased items on an already existing credit card. Police are investigating.

On 06/08/2021, at 1533 hrs, a Wildbrook resident reported suspicious activity in the neighborhood. There were two vehicles parked in the street and four individuals loitering in the area. BVPD officers responded to the area and discovered it was a work crew preparing to install solar panels on a house.
