On 06/27/2021, at 1700 hrs, a Cowles resident reported he was the victim of a scam. Almost \$1,800 in charges had been made using his Apple ID. Police are investigating.

On 06/26/2021, at 1205 hrs, a resident in the 23000 block of Lake Rd. called to report fraud. The resident reported he was checking the current charges on his credit card and noticed a \$10,600 charge was made in Colorado for a car. The resident did not make this purchase, and was unaware how the purchase was made as he still had the credit card in his possession. Police are investigating.

On 06/26/2021, at 0313 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Wolf Rd. near Dover Center for a traffic violation. After speaking with the 18-ya driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the Olmsted Falls resident was arrested OVI. He will face charges at RRMC.

On 06/24/2021, at 0113 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle for suspicious activity. Someone had observed the vehicle pull into the Fire Department parking lot. The male driver got out of his vehicle and urinated. He then got back into his vehicle and left the area. A BVPD officer stopped the vehicle on Sutcliff near Sites. After speaking with the driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI. The 37-ya Lakewood resident will face charges at RRMC.
