



## **Bay Village Press Release**

**07/05/2021**

On 06/30/2021, at 1833 hrs, a resident in the 31000 block of Lake Rd. called BVPD to report a vehicle was parked in her driveway and she had no idea who it belonged to or where the driver was. An officer located the owner next door who was visiting a friend and the vehicle was moved.

On 07/03/2021, at 0147 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Cahoon for multiple traffic violations. After speaking with the 19-yoa driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI. The Pittsburgh resident will face charges at RRMC. A male passenger in the vehicle was found to have an active arrest warrant with Cleveland PD for an OVI. The Cleveland resident was taken into custody on the strength of the warrant and turned over to the custody of the Cleveland Police Department.

On 07/04/2021, at 1755 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Oakmoor for having fictitious license plates. The license plates did not list back to the vehicle or the driver, and the driver could not produce any documentation that he owned the vehicle. The driver also had a suspended driver's license and an active warrant with Bedford Police. The driver was cited for the fictitious plates and driving under suspension. The vehicle was impounded until proof of ownership could be provided. The 27-yoa Cleveland resident was taken into custody on the strength of the warrant from Bedford and turned over to the Bedford Police Department.

On 07/05/2021, at 0331 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Vineland for a traffic violation. After speaking with the male driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the 52-yoa Cleveland resident was arrested for OVI. He will face charges at RRMC.
