On 7/1/2021, Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas Judge Nancy McDonnell sentenced Charles Lemvert Harris Jr. to 7 years in prison for breaking into multiple businesses, including the Breaking and Entering and Theft that occurred at Ross Wine and Liquor in Bay Village on 9/19/2019.

On 07/06/2021, at 1020 hrs, a Woodlane resident called BVPD to report he was receiving threatening communications against him and his family. A report was filed and police are investigating.

On 07/07/2021, at 0217 hrs, a Debbington resident reported someone had rung her doorbell. Officers responded to the area but were unable to locate anyone.

On 07/07/2021, at 1611 hrs, a resident in the 500 block of Forestview called BVPD to report she was missing several thousand dollars worth of jewelry from inside her house. Police are investigating.

On 07/07/2021, at 2204 hrs, a resident reported that he returned to his vehicle after working all day to discover the rear window had been shattered. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate a cause. Police are investigating.

On 07/11/2021, at 0118 hrs, a BVPD officer located two quad runners on Lake Rd. near Upland that were operating at a high rate of speed with no headlights on. There was also a motorcycle following the two ATV's. The officer attempted to stop the group, but they fled westbound on Lake Rd. Officers pursued them to Bradley before discontinuing because of safety concerns, but advised Avon Lake of the pursuit. BVPD officers were able to obtain a license plate off of the motorcycle and obtain the owners information. A short time later, Avon Lake PD called BVPD to report Sheffield Lake had located one of the ATV's and had the operator in custody. As

a result of an investigation BVPD was able to identify two of the three operators. A 33 yoa male from Bedford Heights, and a 27 yoa male from Cleveland will face charges at RRMCC.
