On July 14, at 12:54am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Lake Road at Breezewood Drive for a moving violation. While speaking with the operator, the officer noticed the smell of a THC vape coming from inside the vehicle. Officers spoke with the male who admitted the same. A search of the vehicle found numerous items of drug paraphernalia. The operator will face drug paraphernalia charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On July 14 at 2:34am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Lake Road and Saddler Road when they stopped a vehicle for speeding. The officer spoke with the female operator, an 18 year-old, Cleveland resident who appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which showed a .143% blood alcohol content. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On July 14 at 11:22pm, a Canterbury Road resident called Bay Village Police to report that she was the victim of a fraud. When officers spoke with the victim, she told police that she had noticed several fraudulent deductions from her checking account. The nine charges totaled \$480 dollars. The victim has since cancelled the card. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On July 17 at 2:26am, a Kenilworth Road resident called Bay Village Police to report that someone was outside rummaging through his truck. While the victim was on the phone with police, the suspect, unknown gender and wearing dark clothes, fled the area on foot. Officers arrived on scene and found several cars in the area that appeared to have been entered. The caller reported loose change was taken from inside his vehicle. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.

On July 17 at 11:57pm, a 911 caller notified the Bay Village Police that he was behind a vehicle that was operating erratically in the area of Huntington Beach and Lake Road. Officers caught up to the vehicle soon thereafter and the vehicle was eventually stopped on Bayview Road. Police spoke with the male operator, a 43 year old, Avon Lake resident, who appeared extremely intoxicated. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male submitted to an Intoxilyzer test which provided a .334% blood alcohol content. Two passengers in the suspect vehicle were later picked up by a ride service. No charges filed. The operator of the vehicle is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
