On 07/30/2021, at 1205 hrs, a Dwight resident reported that someone had stolen her identity. She was not out any money at the time of the report, but feared some of her accounts may become compromised. Police are investigating.

On 07/30/2021, at 0040 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Cahoon for several traffic violations. After speaking with the driver, the officer suspected there were drugs in the car. A probable cause search of the vehicle resulted in finding marijuana and drug paraphernalia. The 18-yoa driver (Middleburgh Hts. resident) was cited for Possession of Marijuana Drug Paraphernalia and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The 21-yoa passenger (Fairview Park resident) was cited for Possession of Marijuana Drug Paraphernalia. Both will face charges at RRMC.

On 08/01/2021, at 0142 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Osborn near Douglas for suspicious activity. After speaking with the 22-yoa driver, the officer suspected there were drugs in the car. As the officer continued to speak with the driver, the driver admitted there was a handgun in the glove box. The officer recovered the firearm and a small amount of marijuana from inside the vehicle. The Westlake resident was arrested for Carrying a Concealed Weapons, and will face charges at RRMC.

On 08/02/2021, a Chatham Point Dr. resident reported that over the last few weeks she had been scammed out of approximately \$20,000. She had been contacted by a male caller almost daily who convinced her she had been the victim of identity theft. He told her in order to catch those responsible she had to purchase various gift cards. He would call in the morning and tell her which gift cards to purchase, and then have her scratch off the activation numbers on the back and read them to him. Police are investigating.
