A RESOLUTION
**AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) INTERNATIONAL HV507 SFA 4X2
CHASSIS, ONE (1) INTERNATIONAL HV507 SFA 6X4 CHASSIS,
AND TWO (2) SNOW AND ICE CONTROL PACKAGES,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village Service Department is in need of new vehicles and equipment to replace existing vehicles and equipment per the replacement schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village previously appropriated funds for the purchase of said vehicles and equipment as authorized by Ordinance 20-91 passed by this Council on December 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the needed vehicles are available through the ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the needed Concord equipment is available through the State of Ohio State Term Schedule (STS);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bay Village:


SECTION 1. That the Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to submit purchase orders to purchase the following vehicles and equipment:

- One (1) 2022 International HV507 SFA 4x2 Chassis from Rush Truck Centers, 12970 Snow Road, Parma, OH 44130, per Ohio Department of Transportation's Co-op Contract #023-21, total cost \$85,219.00
- One (1) 2022 International HV507 SFA 6x4 Chassis from Rush Truck Centers, 12970 Snow Road, Parma, OH 44130, per Ohio Department of Transportation's Co-op Contract #023-21, total cost \$94,516.00
- One (1) Concord Truck Equipment Snow and Ice Package installed on a supplied 2022 International HV507 SFA 6x4 Chassis from Concord Road Equipment, 348 Chester Street, Painesville, OH 44077, per State of Ohio State Term Schedule (STS) No: 800925; Index No: STS515, total cost \$75,991.16.
- One (1) Concord Truck Equipment Snow and Ice Package installed on a supplied 2022 International HV507 SFA 4x2 Chassis from Concord Road Equipment, 348 Chester Street, Painesville, OH 44077, per State of Ohio State Term Schedule (STS) No: 800860; Index No: STS515, total cost \$102,324.06.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


