On 09/14/2021, at 0127 hrs, BVPD officers were dispatched to the area of 600 Bradley Rd. on the report of a rollover motor vehicle crash. Upon arrival, officers located an SUV on its side with the suspected male driver standing next to it. After making contact with the 22-ya male, he admitted that he was driver of the vehicle and that he was alone. After speaking with him, officers suspected the driver to be under the influence of drugs. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver will be charged with OVI. Because of the nature of the crash, BVPD Paramedics were called to the scene to check out the driver. The driver was subsequently transported to the hospital. The Bay Village resident will face charges at RRMCC.

On 09/16/2021, at 0136 hrs, BVPD officers were dispatched to the 24000 block of East Oakland for a noise complaint. A resident reported that a neighbor was in his backyard drinking and playing music to loud. Responding officers located the house in question and advised the owner of the complaint. He went inside for the evening.

On 09/18/2021, at 0325 hrs, a resident in the 28000 block of West Oakland called BVPD to report there were two males walking around houses with flashlights. Officers arrived in the area and located the two males. They were looking for a particular address using the flashlights on their phones. One of the males needed to go to a house to pick up some paperwork for work, and they were having a difficult time finding the address. They were assisted with finding the address and sent on their way. BVPD reminds residents to please call when you see suspicious activity.

On 09/18/2021, at 0130 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Queenswood. After speaking with the 52-ya male, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI. The Charleston, West Virginia resident will face charges at RRMCC.
