Deputy Police Officer (part-time)

The City of Bay Village is currently hiring for a part-time Police Officer.

Under the general direction of the Supervisor this position is responsible for patrolling the City of Bay Village, responding to emergency situations, protecting personnel and properties therein, enforcing all applicable laws, maintaining peace and safety, investigating complaints, aiding individuals, identifying criminal offenders, making arrests, identifying law enforcement and community issues, resolving conflicts, engaging with the community in a positive and proactive manner and providing other law enforcement and community policing services to the public as necessary.

Requirements: United States Citizenship; completion of High School or equivalent GED (AB, BA or BS degree from an accredited college or university preferred); must successfully complete all medical, physical, agility, polygraph and/or psychological examinations administered by the City; possess a State of Ohio OPOTA certification; valid Ohio Driver's license; meet state required age requirements; LEADS Certification, Firearm Proficiency Qualification and any other State of Ohio required licenses and/or certifications. A minimum of five years' experience as a police officer preferred.
