**AN ORDINANCE**  
**REPEALING CODIFIED ORDINANCE CHAPTER 935 REGARDING BAYWAY  
YOUTH CABIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 08-102 was adopted on December 15, 2008, establishing the usage of, rental charges and scheduling guidelines for the Bayway Youth Cabin; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bayway Youth Cabin has been razed in preparation of the site for the new Bay Village Branch of the Cuyahoga County Library due to open in April 2022 therefore Bay Village Codified Ordinance Chapter 935 regarding the Bayway Youth is no longer pertinent;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Codified Ordinance Chapter 935 which presently reads as follows:

“Chapter 935 - BAYWAY YOUTH CABIN

935.01 - Charges established.

(a) The Bayway Youth Cabin may be used by community sponsored Bay Village youth-oriented groups and organizations at no charge. Classes A and C may use the building if no youth-oriented activity is scheduled for the time in question. Bay Village residents in Class C may use the building if no other group is scheduled. Groups charging admission fee and/or having live bands must hire a police officer or auxiliary officer for security. (For definition of "Classes," see 929.01)

Annual/repetitive renter shall maintain a Security Deposit.

Scout Troop Overnights No Charge—waiver of liability with verified insurance coverage.

(b) Council, City officials, boards and commission, and pre-teen with parental supervision are permitted to use the facilities for any Municipal purpose or function free of any charge for the use thereof, in the event no youth-oriented activity is scheduled for the time in question.

(c) Security deposit is required (except Class A) prior to issuance of rental permit.

935.02 - Scheduling.

The Recreation Department shall be responsible for the scheduling of activities and rentals.

935.03 - Rules and regulations for use.

The Recreation Department shall recommend rules and regulations for Bayway Youth Cabin use, which rules and regulations shall be approved by the Cahoon Park Trustees.

935.04 - Responsibility of users.

The user shall comply with all rules and regulations. The user shall be responsible for all set-up and return of the equipment and facilities to the condition and arrangement prior to their use. Among other facilities, this shall specifically include the kitchen, its equipment, accessories and utensils. The cost of repairing any damage to the Bayway Youth Cabin or its contents shall be charged directly to the permit holder in occupancy at the time of the damage. Such cost will be charged against the security deposit. Any costs over and above the security deposit will be the responsibility of the permit holder.

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberation of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


