A RESOLUTION
**AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A TRANSFORMATIONAL HABITAT
RESTORATION GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE NATIONAL
OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) has posted a Notice of Funding Opportunity to support transformational projects that restore Great Lakes ecosystems using approaches that enhance community and ecosystem resilience to climate hazards, and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2021, the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio adopted a plan for the Cahoon Memorial Park lakefront known as the Cahoon Park Public Access Study;

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village desires financial assistance through the NOAA funding opportunity to begin implementation of the aforementioned study and is preparing the application for submission;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio;

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes the application to NOAA for financial assistance under a Transformational Habitat Restoration and Coastal Resilience Grant, provision of all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance, and execution of any agreements necessary to receive any awarded funds.

SECTION 2. That Council hereby agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the grant.

SECTION 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to authorize the filing of said application in a timely manner, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


