**RESOLUTION**  
**ESTABLISHING A NEW "ONEOHIO OPIOID  
SETTLEMENT FUND" AS A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO ACCOUNT  
FOR THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF REVENUES RECEIVED  
FROM THE STATE OF OHIO' S ONEOHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENT, AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705. 09( F) requires the City to establish a special fund for each class of revenues derived from a source other than general property tax which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose, and

**WHEREAS**, the OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund will be a Special Revenue fund to account for the revenues received from the State of Ohio's OneOhio Opioid Settlement and will properly account for expenditures specified in the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bay Village will be qualified to receive and should be prepared to accept the transfer or disbursement of monies for approved purposes which are evidence - based forward- looking strategies, programming and services designed to address the following:

- i) Expanding the availability of treatment for individuals affected by substance use disorders;
- ii) Developing, promoting and providing evidence -based substance use prevention strategies;
- iii) Providing substance use avoidance and awareness education,
- iv) Decreasing the oversupply of licit and illicit opioids, and
- v) Supporting recovery for addiction services performed by qualified and appropriately licensed providers; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to establish a "OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund" as a special revenue fund in accordance with the law.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That there is hereby established a separate "OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund" Fund Number 296 as a Special Revenue Fund, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt of funds that are or may be allocated or disbursed to the City of Bay Village by virtue of the "OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund" for the approved purposes as outlined in (MOU).

**SECTION 2.** That the said OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund be and remain for an indefinite term, unless otherwise terminated by Council. And further that the Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay out of said Special Revenue Fund such amounts necessary to meet the costs or expense that meets or exceeds the qualifications and criteria imposed by law.

**SECTION 3.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of

this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


**SECTION 4.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary that this legislation go into effect immediately in order to establish said OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund and begin receiving funds that will assist the community, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
