ORDINANCE
**AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-64 REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF ASPHALT
REJUVENATOR TO THE 2021 REPAVED PORTION OF BRADLEY ROAD,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2022, this Council passed Ordinance 22-64 authorizing an agreement with Pavement Technology, Inc. with a contract amount of Twenty-Four Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (\$24,220.24), as a proposed amount for the purchase of A.R.A.-1 Ti® Asphalt Rejuvenator materials and services for the recently repaved portion of Bradley Road; and

WHEREAS, due to a variance between proposed project quantities and final field measured quantities, the actual amount is Twenty-Nine Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents (\$29,334.69);

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio;

SECTION 1. That the sum of Twenty-Nine Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents (\$29,334.69) is hereby approved for the improvement described above and Pavement Technology, Inc. is authorized to proceed with the adjustment of the final contract value.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
