**A RESOLUTION**  
**AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE**  
**UNDER THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM WITH THE STATE OF**  
**OHIO,**  
**AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bay Village has entered into a cooperative purchasing program with the State of Ohio to participate in State contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, has entered into for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain material pursuant to ORC §125.04, as authorized by Resolution No. 88-33 passed January 4, 1988; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio has, after public bidding, determined that Lebanon Ford is the best bidder for 4 door police sedan interceptors and has awarded them the contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bay Village is in need of a law enforcement vehicle meeting these specifications for the Division of Police;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:


**SECTION 1.** That the Chief of the Division of Police is hereby authorized and directed to submit a purchase order to Lebanon Ford, 770 Columbus Ave, Lebanon, OH 45036, for the purchase of one (1) 2018 Ford Sedan Police Interceptor under the cooperative purchasing program of the State of Ohio. Total contract price not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand, Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$24,448.00), including delivery, shall be paid from the Equipment Replacement Fund/Police (240.111.55220).


**SECTION 2.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to submit said purchase order to meet the cut-off date for ordering law enforcement vehicles, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
